Provenance

Presented by Ms Sheila Howell of Shrivenham, Swindon, in January 2010. Ms Howell used to work for a solicitor in Epsom and rescued the deed when it was being discarded to make more space. The deed was made into a lampshade in the 1960s and has now been flattened.

2 May 1794

- 1) Philip Wright of Ewell, brewer, and Elizabeth his wife
- 2) Robert Street of Ewell, butcher.

Messuage or tenement, garden and hop ground containing c.1/4 of an acre of land in Ewell near the Green Man Alehouse on the road leading from Ewell to Epsom, now in the occupation of Wright and James Chandler.

The property had previously been conveyed to Wright by John Harris (amongst other premises) by lease and release of 9 and 10 May 1779
